

Brent Mayr:

I built this firm with the idea that we wanted to provide the very best criminal defense representation to our clients. We wanted to help people when they were going through some of the darkest times of their lives.

Just because you're innocent or not guilty of the offense, doesn't mean that the state or the prosecutor is going to agree with you. You still have to fight the case to the fullest extent, and the biggest mistake you can make is trying to handle it without an experienced attorney.

Sierra Tabone:

When you're accused of a crime, the client ultimately wants the case to be dismissed or, in some situations, declined. They want it gone and to not have to deal with it. I have the record of the no bills and the dismissals and have the outcomes that my clients want. I had one case where a niece was accusing her uncle of sexual assault, and looking at the evidence, it was a fabricated claim. We were able to put together what's called a grand jury packet and get the case no billed, meaning that grand jury found no probable cause. And being able to tell my client that the case was over, that this stigma would no longer carry on with him, and he would be able to be with his own kids, be able to take them to school again, just makes my day. You want to look for someone who has a plan of attack. The plan that the attorney has in attacking a sexual assault case or any case, for that matter, is the most important thing.

Brent Mayr:

We're always looking at it from the standpoint of what's going to happen at the end of the day. Is this a case that's going to go to trial? Is this a case that we think that we can get dismissed? Pleading guilty is always the last option because we ultimately want to find whether or not the state can prove their case beyond a reasonable doubt. Sierra has the knowledge and experience to handle these cases from the very outset and has an exceptional record of convincing prosecutors and grand juries and judges to dismiss.

Sierra Tabone:
